



## Booking for Buzzed Bard

Do you own or manage a restaurant, bar, brewery, or distillery looking for fun cultural events? The Pigeon Creek Shakespeare Company's Buzzed Bard programming brings an evening of Shakespearean scenes,

### How does it work?

The establishments that we work with have used two basic models for presenting Buzzed Bard.

One option is to do a special event, dinner theatre performance. In this case, you would plan a dinner and we would structure our performance so that each course of the dinner has entertainment to go with it. You would charge your guests a per person fee that includes \$10 per person for the performance. You would then send our company a check for that \$10 per person.

The second option is to serve your regular menu and charge a cover for the performance. We are able to set up an Eventbrite event to do pre-sales for that cover charge. Keep in mind that this option does mean that people walking up to your business on the event date would need to pay the cover in order to see the performance.

We ask venues to actively participate in promoting these events, and we request that the performers be allowed to collect tips at the performance. For venues further than 50 miles from Grand Rapids, we do charge mileage for our actors' travel. For venues further than 100 miles from Grand Rapids, we will require overnight lodging for 5-6 actors.
